Technology is an essential part of the New Zealand curriculum and, at our centre in Hillcrest Road, students have the opportunity to use a wide variety of tools and specialist equipment to complete a range of projects which in 2017 included: wooden race track, mini BBQ table, pencil case, bag, movie, maze, electronic toy/vehicle, recipes etc.
