Dates/Times

Please find the timetable on the back of this notice, your ferry time and group for the day. If you cannot find your child's name, please contact me (dclare@raumatibeach.school.nz). Parent helpers please be aware you may not be on the same boat as your child.

Postponement Date

There are no current postponement dates due to peak bookings for the charter company. We may be able to negotiate extra dates if trips are cancelled due to weather/marine conditions, but we cannot guarantee a new date will be given.

Parent Helpers

All parent helpers have been contacted and confirmed. If you haven't paid yet for your trip (\$40) please do this through the school shop (Kindo) asap. If you had your name down but haven't been contacted please assume you are not needed for the day. We really appreciate the offer though.

Cancellation

If the ferry provider decides that we need to cancel the trip, the notice will be posted at approximately 7.30am on the Team Kapiti Google Classroom and Seesaw.

Getting to the Ferry/Ferry Times

Students are to be dropped off and picked up from the Kapiti Boat Club, Paraparaumu Beach. If you are completely stuck, please contact David Clare. **ALL students for boats 1 and 2 must arrive by 7:50am for check in.**

First ferry - Boat leaves at **8:15am**. *These students will return to Kapiti Boat Club ready to be collected by approx 2:45pm.*

Second ferry - Boat leaves at **9.00am**. *These students will return to Kapiti Boat Club ready to be collected by 3:30pm.*

Day Bag, Gear List for Students and Parent Helpers

Togs, towel, full set of clothes to walk in (mufti), appropriate walking shoes (sport shoes, not street shoes), hat, sunscreen, sunglasses (optional), warm jersey, windbreaker/rain jacket, enough food for morning tea, lunch and afternoon tea, drink bottle, medication (if any). Due to space restrictions on the boat, **STUDENTS ARE NOT TO BRING SNORKEL GEAR, IT WILL BE PROVIDED FOR YOU.** For parent helpers who are in the water more than once, you can bring snorkelling gear if you feel more comfortable, (if bringing a wetsuit make sure it is a thick one 7mm+) otherwise use the one provided by MSR.
