Dear Parents & Guardians,

SCHOOL SORES

We have had a case of Impetigo (School Sores) reported in your child's team.

This is a bacterial infection and sores erupt on the skin, sometimes beginning with watery blisters that develop into moist, crusty patches. The sores can spread very easily to other parts of the infected person's body.

School sores are spread by direct contact with the sores of an infected person or by handling contaminated clothing, toys etc. A child with dry, cracked skin can pick up the infection very quickly.

This is infectious during the time there is a discharge from the sores and until treatment has begun. Sores are usually treated with antibiotics.
