TO REGISTER

1. Go online to [Tough Guy and Gal Junior Challenge Event Promotions](#) to register and pay for your child. There is a question section where you must put in Raumati Beach School's full name and tick a box to say the teacher is picking up the race bag on the day of the event. This means they can link Raumati Beach School students together and have everything waiting for us when we arrive on the day. If you do not do this then you could be waiting in a huge queue to get your child's registration pack.

2. Once you have paid and registered online, please go to your school Kindo account and fill out all the details on there as well. This includes medical and emergency contact details.
