A few reminders before camp....

### **Dates and Times**

Camp One students (Rooms 10, 11 and 12) will be heading to camp on Tuesday 5 November and returning on Friday 8 November (week 4).

Camp Two students (Rooms 19, 20 and 21) will be heading to camp on Tuesday 19 November and returning on Friday 22 November (week 6).

The buses leave school at 9.30am sharp. **All students must be at school by 8.30am on the Tuesday morning of their camp week.** This allows time for the buses to be loaded up with the gear. We will return on the Friday afternoon around 3pm.

**All students and adults need a packed lunch from home on Tuesday.**

### **Medication and Health Needs**

Please make sure that any personal medication listed on your child's medical form is named and handed in to your child's class teacher **with the name of medication, dosage and times clearly labelled, in a zip-lock bag.**

If your child has come into contact with any infectious illnesses in the two weeks prior to camp, please let your class teacher know.

### **Equipment**

The camp equipment list was sent home last term. You can also find a copy of this list on our school website, (Team Notices/Te Moana 5/6). Paper copies are available on request.

The equipment list has now been amended to include pillows (as camp does not provide any), extra blankets if desired, toiletries and towels. Please pack your child's bag based on the new list and label all of your child's gear.

***It is very important that your child is kept warm while on camp, especially at night. Thermal leggings and tops are perfect nightwear for this camp.***

For students who are bedwetters, please either pack an extra sleeping bag, or let your child's class teacher know should you require a spare one from camp.

Named board games can be handed to the class teacher and placed in boxes for camp.

## **Correspondence**

There is no cell phone coverage at the camp. Makahika has requested that if you need to contact your child's class teacher, please contact Raumati Beach School in the first instance to pass messages on. Please only contact the camp under exceptional circumstances.

## **Final Camp Payment Reminder**

A reminder that the fourth and final camp payment of **\$40 is due by Friday 25 October.**

**All** camp fees must be paid for before your child attends camp.
