These are the rules that I agree to follow during our camp. I understand that these rules are there to ensure that camp is safe and enjoyable for all.

- If you are asked to do a task, do it – even if it is not your responsibility.
- Stay out of other tents/cabins.
- Be courteous, cooperative and respectful to all adults.
- Do a fair share of duties; show up on time.
- Stay within the boundaries.
- Respect other people's feelings and property; be kind to others.
- Respect other people's privacy.
- Leave equipment/gear in a tidy condition.
- Listen to, and follow all instructions.
- "Lights out" means no talking.
- Always wear footwear around camp.
- Stay in your tents/cabins at night, unless it's for a bathroom visit, an emergency, or seeking the assistance of an adult.
- Remember to stay in your tent/cabin in the morning until you are told.
- Be considerate of others in the morning – keep quiet.
- Always be with another member of our group.
- Follow the Safety Codes on each camp activity; make sure you are with an adult if the Code says so.
- No devices are to be brought to camp.
- No lollies, drinks, or other confectionery are to be brought to camp.

Consequences for choosing to break rules

I have read and understood the camp contract.

Strike Three: Third offence: Miss whole day of activities. Parents will be contacted for a conference at camp.

Any incidence of severe misconduct may result in the student being sent home. Parents will be contacted and may be expected to collect their child from camp as soon as possible.

Note: This decision will be made in consultation with attending adults and Principal/BoT Chairperson, but is ultimately decision of Teacher in Charge. If a student is sent home, no refund of camp costs is possible and parents will pay transport costs.
