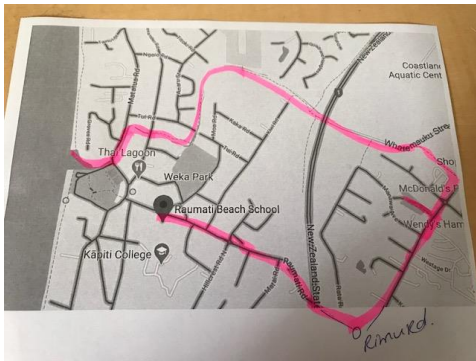
Dear Parents & Guardians,

TE MOANA - YRS 3 & 4 - SCHOOL JOURNEY WALK

As you may be aware, this term our inquiry topic has been identity. This has included exploring who the children are, who their classmates are and where they fit in the school. To help illustrate where the students fit into the school we would like to take them for a walk along the Wharemauku stream to physically walk the journey that illustrates their path through school.
