Dear Parents and Guardians

We are just over the half way mark of the term. Last week we kicked off the first of a number of in-school competitions that will lead to students being selected to represent Raumati Beach against Raumati South School in our inaugural "Heritage Cup," Competition.

The Heritage Cup is a trophy which will be competed for between the two Raumati Schools and sponsored by Heritage Barbers. The cup will be a series of annual competitions between the schools. Competitions will vary from "Sporting," to "Cultural," with points going towards finding the overall winner.

Points System

Points will be cumulative throughout the year. With all points going towards finding an overall winner.

- Win will be worth five points.
- Loss will be worth two points.

The Cup winner will be determined after the final event has taken place. The trophy will be awarded at an assembly organised by the winning school.

We look forward to this becoming an annual event between the two Raumati Schools and will let you know more as events are scheduled. Currently students from Year 5 to Year 8 are involved in a Five-A-Side Football competition with the rounds being played most morning tea and lunchtimes. The winners of each of the categories will go on to represent RBS. Our in-school finals for the Year 7 & 8 competitions were scheduled for today – Thursday 10th June.

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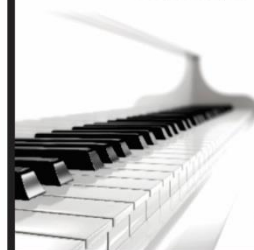

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
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
