Our RBS Showcase will be viewed in term 4, Week 7 & 8 – 23rd November – 4th December

There are 4 categories, Singing, Dancing/Gymnastics, Drama/Comedy and Musical Instruments. Entrants will be showcased in year groups as follows:

Wharemauku: Years 1- 2

Te Moana: Years 3 - 4

Te Moana: Years 5 - 6

Kapiti: Years 7- 8

To enable entrants to prepare efficiently, these are the rules.

Rules

- Items should be approximately 2 minutes long and start with an introduction, **which includes, your name, name of act, and what category your act is.**
- Bands need to play their own music, if they have a backing track, it becomes another category- Drama.
- No songs with inappropriate words/themes, *this includes music you are dancing to as well.*
- Please make sure you let your teachers and audience know if you have composed/choreographed/written your own act.
- If you are entering the singing category and singing using a backing track ensure there are no other vocals on it (you can't sing along with the original artist). Backing tracks can be found on youtube.
- Your act may be provided to your teacher via youtube link, or usb stick.
- Your teacher will record your act and details on the showcase entrant's form.
